

## **'Join a Friend' campaign Prize Draw Terms & Conditions**

1. This free prize draw is organised by the LibrariesWest consortium of local authorities, comprising Bath & North East Somerset, Bristol, North Somerset, Somerset and South Gloucestershire.
2. All new individual members joining a LibrariesWest library as a result of the 'Join a Friend' campaign between 1<sup>st</sup> February 2010 and 30<sup>th</sup> April 2010 will automatically be entered in the free prize draw, unless they have instructed us otherwise. All members who 'recruit' another member will also be entered in the free prize draw, unless they have instructed us otherwise.
3. Library members who are defaulted at the time of the prize draw will not be eligible to be entered into the draw.
4. The closing date for the draw is 30th April 2010.
5. There will be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> prizes. 1<sup>st</sup> prize will be a 32- inch Widescreen HD Ready LCD TV with Freeview, 2nd prize will be a Blu-ray Player, 3<sup>rd</sup> prize will be a Digital Camera and 4th prize will be £50 of [www.amazon.co.uk](http://www.amazon.co.uk) vouchers.
6. The winners will be drawn at random as soon as possible after the closing date and will be notified within 2 weeks of the free prize draw taking place. If a winner does not contact us within 20 working days of being told they have won, we may pick an alternative winner. If the winner is a child or young person under 16, their parent or carer will be notified.
7. Once notified by us, the winners will need to contact us to arrange collection of the prize from a library. Each prize must be collected by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2010.
8. We will not pass winners' or entrants' contact details to any third party without their consent.
